Homefield exists to serve the care needs of our residents and their families and friends, in a comfortable and loving environment. We encourage independence and freedom of choice, whilst promoting the dignity and individuality of all those in our care.

Care plans are developed for each resident by our nurses, together with our residents and their advocates. We are able to provide advance care planning and palliative care.

Our nurses and carers provide full nursing and clinical care 24 hours a day. They are dedicated to caring for our residents with dignity, respect and compassion and to serving our residents' social, physical, clinical and emotional needs.

OUR STAFF

Our staff are loyal and hardworking, ensuring a strong continuity of care for our residents. All staff complete a thorough induction on commencing work and will continue to receive regular training throughout their career with us.

DINING

All meals are prepared onsite using fresh ingredients. Menus are prepared and updated on a regular basis, in full consultation with our residents and their advocates. We are committed to ensuring that any dietary needs and preferences are met and that varied and nutritional meals are available to suit every cultural and personal choice.

ACCOMMODATION

Our residents' bedrooms are spacious and accessible, set over three floors and serviced by a lift. All bedrooms are spacious, secure and well appointed, with pleasant views onto our gardens or the surrounding residential area. Additional bathrooms are located on each wing.

Whilst rooms are presented fully furnished to a high decorative standard, we encourage our residents to personalise their bedrooms as they wish.
