Love Walk is located in a beautiful part of Denmark Hill, on the edge of the Camberwell Conservation Area. A social care facility has stood at 10 Love Walk since 1911. We offer a warm and loving home, with a high standard of person-centred care, to 22 adults living with physical disabilities.



LIFE AT LOVE WALK

Love Walk exists to serve the care needs of our residents and their families and friends, in a comfortable and loving environment. We encourage independence and freedom of choice, whilst promoting the dignity and individuality of all those in our care.

Care plans for each resident are developed by our care team, together with residents and their advocates.

Our care team provide full care to our residents 24 hours a day. They are dedicated to caring for our residents with dignity, respect and compassion and to serving our residents' social, physical, clinical and emotional needs.

OUR STAFF

Our staff are loyal and hardworking, ensuring a strong continuity of care for our residents. All staff complete a thorough induction on commencing work and will continue to receive regular training throughout their career with us.

DINING

All meals are prepared onsite using fresh ingredients. Menus are prepared and updated on a regular basis, in full consultation with our residents and their advocates. We are committed to ensuring that any dietary needs and preferences are met and that varied and nutritional meals are available to suit every cultural and personal choice.

ACCOMMODATION

Our 21 bedrooms are spread across two accessible floors. All bedrooms are generously sized and well appointed with en-suite facilities. All bedrooms enjoy views onto Love Walk or our terraced area. A self-contained flat is available for a resident nearing the end of their rehabilitation.

Whilst rooms are presented fully furnished to a high decorative standard, we encourage our residents to personalise their bedrooms as they wish.
